March 29, 2012

A regular meeting of the Bedford Public Library Board of Trustees was held on March 29, 2012 in the New Hampshire Room. Old Business:

Director's Evaluation – Still outstanding.

New Business:

Van Service Changes – Additional cuts from the state for van deliveries will be in effect in April. GMILCS is contracting with a local courier to supplement.

Elevator – We have had multiple calls to the elevator company as the elevator would get stuck between floors. It was unclear what caused the problem. Several parts have been replaced.

Precision Temperature Control contract – The Trustees unanimously approved renewing the maintenance agreement with Precision Temperature Control for 2012.

Craftworkers' Guild electric bill – The library is responsible for the electric bill for the time we used the building. The Trustees approved payment of the bill.

Library Foundation request – The Foundation will be considering items to fund in April.

NH Library Trustees Association Conference – The conference will be held May 21.

Policy on Photography, Videotaping, and Use of other Recording Devices – Ed will contact LGC to determine what the law is regarding videotaping in public buildings.
