July 25, 2013

A regular meeting of the Bedford Public Library Board of Trustees was held on July 25, 2013 in the New Hampshire Room. In attendance were Ed Moran (Chair), Walter Gallo (Trustee), Tony Frederick (Treasurer), Mary Ann Senatro (Library Director), and Miriam Johnson (Assistant Director). The meeting was called to order at 8:01 a.m.

Secretary's Report – Minutes from the June 27, 2013 meeting were accepted and approved. **Treasurer's Report** – The Treasurer's report was reviewed and accepted. Old Business:

Behavior Policy – No changes will be made at this time.

Emergency Shelter – Request received from the Bedford Village Morning School to list the library as an emergency shelter. Mary Ann consulted with the Fire Department and they were fine with that.

Reading – Ed proposed that we encourage people to read to Seniors who may be visually impaired. Mary Ann shared the "Take Time to Read" idea.
