HVAC – We did not renew our maintenance contract for HVAC since we are unsure of what will transpire with the system replacement this year. Jim Stanford is working on an RFP. Mary Ann will ask him about the feasibility of moving the equipment from the attic.

Friends of the Library – The Friends are planning a ½ K road race and would like to purchase a 3-D fabricator for the library.

Library Foundation – They will host a Leen Lecture on May 8 featuring Gil Shattuck, who will talk about the Hillsborough collection of ½ million photographs that they are digitizing and organizing.

Community Profiles Policy – We can now input information about community groups into our catalog. We have not yet written a policy, but would like to begin with inputting Bedford community groups that serve Bedford substantially.

Medical Leave – Mary Ann will be on medical leave beginning on March 14 for 4-6 weeks. **Windows 7** – The end of support for Windows XP is in April. All machines will be upgraded.

Library Trustee Association Conference – This year's conference will be on May 19th at the Grappone Center in Concord.
